CREATING ONE'S OWN STORY ABOUT ONE'S HOME COUNTRY USING THE STORYTELLING METHOD

STAGE NAME	TIPS	YOUR NOTES
BEGINNING	<p>Introduce your little homeland, the protagonist and the context, describe why he or she is important in your story.</p> <p>Remember that at this point you already need to know how the story will end and what you want to say to your audience with it.</p>	
PROBLEM	<p>Outline the problem faced by the hero of your little homeland you depicted and describe why it is so significant to him/her (you can be this hero too).</p>	
FAILED ATTEMPT OF SOLVING THE PROBLEM	<p>Describe the protagonist's first and unsuccessful attempt to deal with a problem from his/her individual perspective. Describe what the protagonist felt at that moment and how this failure affected him.</p>	
SOLVING THE PROBLEM	<p>Describe the situation that led to the resolution of the problem paying particular attention to the elements likely to elicit emotion.</p>	
CONCLUSION	<p>End the story with some kind of conclusion that will be meaningful to your audience.</p>
